### TUMBLE AND LEARN POLICIES AND CONTRACT

Dress Code:

Tumble and Learn is an active play preschool and students need to be dressed for active play. We recommend that our students wear shorts, leggings, or pants instead of dresses and skirts. Each day will include a tumbling lesson and students will have a hard time participating if they are not dressed appropriately. Athletic shoes such as tennis shoes or sneakers are required but do not have to be left on during the school day.


#### Personal Belongings:


For safety reasons, please do not allow your child to bring any toys or candy to school. Toys can easily become broken, lost, or stolen. Teachers will not be responsible for toys brought to school. Candy and gum are not allowed at school at any time. Teachers are not responsible for lost or broken jewelry or personal property. Backpacks are required for each day of school. Backpacks should be appropriate to the size of your student.
Backpacks with wheels are NOT allowed; they are too cumbersome and impractical for young children to handle independently. Please send an extra change of clothes to school enclosed in a Ziploc bag in your child's backpack everyday. Please include the following items: Underwear, socks, pants or shorts and a shirt.
Accidents and spills happen. The change of clothes will be stored in your child's backpack and there is an accident, the school will provide a change of clothes and your account will be billed \$40.

<u>Snack:</u>

During school students will have a designated snack time. This time will be roughly 10-15 minutes. Your child will not be required to eat but will have the opportunity. You must pack your child a snack in a lunch box to make it easy for them to remove from their backpack and take to the classroom. If you throw a few ziplock bags in or a few snack just in their backpack, it makes it hard for your little one to independently bring them on their own. Please pack a lunch box with a few snacks and a water bottle. If there is a child in your class that has a food allergy, you will be notified and will have to refrain from bringing that item to school. The following snacks are not allowed at school: fruit cups, yogurt in tubes, candy, soda, and anything that needs to be heated up. All snack items are required to be inside a lunch box. This makes it easier for snack time and clean up.

I have read and understand all the above listed policies. I agree to adhere to these guidelines and will support and encourage my child in doing so as well. I understand that failure to adhere to these guidelines will result in my or my child's dismissal from the Tumble and Learn program.





#### Calendar and Closures:

Tumble and Learn is open throughout the year, September 2024 – June 2025. Our full calendar is available on our website at www.thunderelite.com/tumbleandlearn for all themed days and special events with our school.

Tuition is based on 10 months (September through June). Some months have 4 weeks, and some have 5 weeks; thus we do not prorate tuition for holidays, vacations, or closures. Time-off/Vacation time is already factored into tuition and will not be refunded or prorated. Monthly tuition fees are non-refundable regardless of holidays, illness, pandemic, vacation, inclement weather days or "Acts of God". We follow the North Clackamas School District for all winter weather closures. Parents will be notified in advance of these closures and the week of a reminder will be sent out. Tumble and Learn will make reasonable efforts to remain open in inclement weather; however, we may choose to close at the preschool director's discretion. Parents should check for emails and Facebook group regarding school closures.

#### Daily Activities and Schedule:

The daily schedule is a rotating day to include but not limited to open play time, tumbling lessons, fine motor practice, gross motor practice, interactive calendar and learning games, arts and crafts, story time, sensory play and more. Drop off and pick up times are only allowed during the open play times indicated below. All students must be at least 2.5 years old and fully potty trained prior to the start of school. Our school year runs from September-June. Please note: Age is determined by your child's age on 9/01/2024

Sunbursts Ages 3.5-5 Mondays and Wednesdays 9:00-9:15am Drop off and 12:45-1:00pm Pick up


Raindrops Ages 2.5-3.5 Tuesdays and Thursdays 8:30-8:45am Drop off and 11:15-11:30am Pick Up

Dropping off and picking up outside of this window disrupts the learning. We ask that families respect this window and adhere to this time frames. Teachers are spending their after school time planning for the next days of school and meeting, please make sure your are on time to pick up.

<u>We lock/unlock the front door promptly at the times indicated below for extra safety.</u>

The doors will remain locked the entirety of the school day.

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#### <u>Discipline:</u>


Tumble and Learn promotes positive behavior in children and helps them learn self control, which is the ultimate goal of discipline. We want to teach and lead our children to make better choices. All discipline actions will be positive in nature. Separate the child from the behavior, redirect the child's behavior, give acceptable choices, use positive language, refuse to argue on non-negotiable issue, and/or look for a deeper solution. Tumble and Learn teachers are gentle in nature and will guide you child to take deep breaths and help the m communicate their thought and feelings with their peers, teachers and parents calmly and effectively.

Secondly, teachers will explain to the child why the behavior is inappropriate and suggesting if the behavior happens again, he/she will have to sit with the teacher and take a break from the activity and regroup or calm down. The third step for children over the age of three is a brief time-out, one minute per age of the child. Usually, for children of any age, a quiet minute by themselves removed from the situation is all it takes for the child to be able to calm down If the unacceptable behavior continues, parents may receive a communication about the child's behavior in order to work together on a plan with the teachers and/or the director. At no time will any form of corporal punishment be threatened, encouraged, or used. A parent, teacher, and director conference may be called so all involved are using the same methods of encouragement or discipline. Consistency between all groups usually makes a world of difference.

#### <u>Birthdays:</u>

You may bring cupcakes or cookies to school for your child's birthday. The cookies or cupcakes will be distributed during snack time. We do not allow birthday cakes or parties in the classroom due to lack of time and space limitations. We do not have the tools for serving cakes (plates, knives, forks etc). Also, please keep in mind that not all students celebrate birthdays and some children may not be able to participate in birthday celebrations at all. Please ask your teachers if there are any allergy concerns for your child's class before you choose what to bring.

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#### <u>Illness:</u>

We understand that life comes up, and that occasionally there may be an illness or emergency that requires your student to miss school. We ask that if your child is ill, he/she stays home if they have any of the following illnesses or symptoms listed: Vomiting, Diarrhea, Pink Eye, Lice, Fever, Persistent Hacking Cough, Rashes such as staph, hand foot and mouth, ringworm or any other highly contagious airborne illnesses. Please notify your teachers if you know your child will not be coming to school.

#### Medical Release:








entire year of preschool. Tuition is charged September 2024 - June 2025.

I understand and agree that tuition payments are due no later than the 1st of each month. I understand that I am required to provide a VISA or MasterCard, and that my charge card or debit card will be charged by the 6th of each month by Thunder Elite All-Star Cheerleading. If I do not want my card to be charged, I understand that I will have to pay my student's tuition via cash or check to Thunder Elite All-Star Cheerleading before the 5th of each month.

I agree to pay the full amount of \$320 per month if my child is enrolled in Raindrops class and \$420 per month if my child is enrolled in Sunbursts class. I also agree to pay \$50 at time of registration and a supply fee of \$100 for Raindrops and \$125 for Sunburst on 9/1.

I also understand and agree that I am subject to a late fee of 18% of any open balance if payment has not been made and my credit/debit card is declined. Excessive tardiness in payment will be grounds for dismissal from the program and my account being sent to a professional collections agency. I understand and agree that any NSF returned checks are subject to a \$35 fee.

Cancellation:

Our School requires a 30 day written notice of withdrawal from Tumble and Learn. If advanced notice of withdrawal is not provided, the standard tuition fee shall be charged for that period. If there is tuition that is due before your 30 days ends you will still be required to pay.
